



About the Fun Run Series

Lace up and enjoy the fun! Fun Runs are free community events held up to three times per year, in the spring, summer and/or fall. Each event draws an average of is 150 – 200 participants. Fun Runs take place in several large CWPD community parks — Forest Field, Oak Grove or Schoolhouse Parks. Each of the parks feature popular playgrounds, clean restrooms, athletic fields, large group picnic shelters and ample parking, making them an ideal setting for family-friendly outdoor fun!

Fun Runs feature a one-mile course on accessible surfaces with themed activities and nature education facts along the way, plus a 100-meter dash for our younger participants. The welcome area to every Fun Run features games, activities and/or crafts, depending upon the event's theme.

Lights, laughter and community under the stars! Movie Parties in the Park are among CWPD's most popular family events, drawing 400–500 attendees to each of the three movie nights held annually. Events are hosted at community parks. The 2026 Movie Parties will be held at Forest Field, Oak Creek South and Yankee Parks. Both parks offer playgrounds, restrooms, picnic shelters and plenty of space for families to relax and enjoy the show.

Each Movie Party begins with themed crafts, snacks, games and food trucks, all tied to that evening's movie. When the sun sets, families settle in to watch a beloved film on a giant inflatable screen!

About Halloween Hop & Howl

CWPD's sixth annual Halloween Hop & Howl series will take place in 2026! The free Hop & Howl events began as charming self-guided Halloween experiences for preschoolers and their families. The events have grown each year, both in terms of activities offered and attendance. Families visit sponsored allergy-free treat stations along the way.

Halloween Hop & Howl is designed to be inclusive for all participants, featuring a paved trail for easy accessibility and offering **only allergy-friendly giveaways**.

In 2026, Halloween Hop & Howl will take place on Thursday, October 1, and Thursday, October 8, from 4 to 5:30 p.m. at one of the Park District's most popular parks, Forest Field Park (2100 E. Centerville Station Rd.). The event time provides a convenient window to give many families the opportunity to attend.

Forest Field Park is a 44-acre community park with all-access traditional playground equipment, a natural play area, a large group picnic shelter and indoor restrooms.

Station Sponsor Requirements

There is **no cost** for businesses to participate in Halloween Hop & Howl. To participate you must:

- Be at Forest Field Park from 3:30 to 6 p.m. on event days. The events run from 4 to 5:30 p.m.
- Provide a table decorated in fall, Halloween, and/or your business theme; chairs are recommended.
- Provide at least 250 free giveaways per event night. All giveaways must be peanut, tree-nut, gluten and dairy free. Non-food giveaways children will enjoy are also welcome.
- Help CWPD deliver fun, healthy and outstanding park experiences by enthusiastically interacting with the children.
- Wear name tags or business logo wear.
- Submit a signed CWPD sponsor contract.

Please note Halloween Hop & Howl events are outdoors and weather-dependent.

Station Sponsor Benefits

In appreciation for your participation, you will receive:
